Objective	Measure	
1 Record patient demographics (sex, race, ethnicity, date of birth, and preferred language)	More than 50% of patients' demographic data recorded as structured data	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
2 Record vital signs (height, weight, and blood pressure for age 2 and higher)	More than 50% of patients 2 years of age or older have height, weight, and blood pressure recorded as structured data	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
3 Maintain up-to-date problem list of current and active diagnoses	More than 80% of patients have at least one entry recorded as structured data or an indication that they have no problems	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
4 Maintain active medication list	More than 80% of patients have at least one entry recorded as structured data or an indication they are on no medications	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
5 Maintain active medication allergy list	More than 80% of patients have at least one entry recorded as structured data or an indication that they have no allergies	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
6 Record smoking status for patients 13 years of age or older	More than 50% of patients 13 years of age or older have smoking status recorded as structured data	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
7 Provide patients with clinical summary for each office visit	Clinical summaries provided to patients for more than 50% of all office visits within 3 business days	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
8 On request, provide patients with an electronic copy of their health information (including diagnostic test results, problem list, medication lists, medication allergies)	More than 50% of requesting patients receive electronic copy within 3 business days	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR

2 Incorporate clinical laboratory test results into EHRs as structured data	More than 40% of clinical laboratory test results whose results are in positive / negative or numerical format are incorporated into EHRs as structured data	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR Lab Interface Recommended
3 Generate lists of patients by specific conditions to use for quality improvement, reduction of disparities, research, or outreach	Generate at least one listing of patients with a specific condition	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
4 Use EHR technology to identify patient-specific education resources and provide those to the patient as appropriate	More than 10% of patients are provided patient-specific education resources	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR
5 Perform medication reconciliation between care settings	Medication reconciliation is performed for more than 50% of transitions of care	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR

9 Send reminders to patients (per patient preference) for preventive and follow-up care	More than 20% of patients 65 years of age or older or 5 years of age or younger are sent appropriate reminders	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR, Patient Portal Recommended
10 Provide patients with timely electronic access to their health information (including laboratory results, problem lists, medication lists, medication allergies)	More than 10% of patients are provided electronic access to information within 4 days of its being updated in the EHR	SuiteMed IMS Ambulatory EHR, Patient Portal or other PHR
